ORDER EXTENDING TIME TO RESPOND

On April 1, 2015,¹ Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed its 2014 cost study detailing its latest cost estimate for decommissioning the company's Callaway nuclear power plant. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to accept its cost report, approve the company's decommissioning cost estimate, continue the company's annual accrual at current levels, and find that Callaway decommissioning costs are included in Ameren Missouri's current cost of service and are properly reflected in current rates for ratemaking purposes.

The Staff of the Commission responded on July 31. Staff states that due to press of business, it will be unable to file either a stipulation with Ameren Missouri, or a recommendation, until November 2. Staff represents that Ameren Missouri does not object to Staff's request for an extension of time until November 2.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall respond to Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Application no later than November 2, 2015. Staff may request additional time if it is unable to offer its recommendation by that date.
