On June 4, 2010,¹ Kansas City Power & Light Company submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The Commission received intervention requests from Dogwood Energy, LLC and IBEW Local Unions 1464, 1613 and 412.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days to respond to motions. No party responded to these applications to intervene. Therefore, the Commission will take up these applications unopposed.

Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4) allows the Commission to grant intervention to a person who has an interest different from that of the general public and which may be adversely affected by a final order arising from the case, or if granting intervention would serve the public interest. Upon review of the unopposed applications, the Commission finds that each of the applicants meets the standard in Commission Rule 4 CSR

240-2.075(4). Therefore, the Commission will grant each of the above-mentioned applications to intervene.

1. The applications to intervene filed by Dogwood Energy, LLC and IBEW Local

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
