ORDER SETTING BLOCKS OF EXHIBIT NUMBERS

On June 4, 2010, Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L-GMO submitted to the Commission proposed tariff sheets intended to implement a general rate increase for electrical service provided in its Missouri service area. The hearing on KCP&L's request is set to begin on January 18.

To attempt to speed the process of marking exhibits at the hearing, the Commission will assign blocks of exhibit numbers to each party. Each party shall receive a block of two hundred numbers for its exhibits. Should a party wish to introduce or refer to more than two hundred exhibits, the Commission will address that request during the hearing.

In addition to the below referenced numbering system, each exhibit shall have either the prefix "KCP&L" for ER-2010-0355, or "GMO" for ER-2010-0356. For example, Staff's first exhibit in ER-2010-0355 would be labeled "KCP&L-201", and Staff's first exhibit in ER-2010-0356 would be labeled "GMO-201".

Furthermore, the Commission will adopt the order of issues proposed by KCP&L. While the Commission understands the positions argued by Staff and MEUA, the Commission concludes that KCP&L has the burden to put on its case, and should be granted considerable leeway in the order in which it would like to present its evidence.
