**ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RESPONSE
AND SETTING A DEADLINE FOR OTHER RESPONSES**

On December 31, 2020, Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West (collectively “Evergy”) filed a motion for clarification or rehearing. Evergy requests clarification of language about recovery under the Pay As You Save (PAYS) program in the Commission’s Report & Order. The Commission’s Report & Order requires Evergy and the parties to file a proposed PAYS pilot program within 60 days of the Report & Order’s effective date.

Staff will file a response addressing Evergy’s motion, and any other party may respond to Evergy’s motion.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Staff of the Public Service Commission shall file a response to Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West’s motion for clarification or rehearing no later than January 7, 2020, at noon.

2. Any other party wishing to respond to Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West’s motion for clarification or rehearing, shall respond no later than January 7, 2020, at noon.

3. This order is effective when issued.
