## ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO REPLY TO AMEREN MISSOURI'S RESPONSE TO ALLEGED DEFICIENCIES

Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri has filed its 2020 Integrated Resource Plan (IRP), as required by the Commission's Electric Utility Resource Planning Rule, 20 CSR 4240-22. As required by 20 CSR 4240-22.080(7), the Commission's Staff reviewed Ameren Missouri's IRP and filed a report on March 31, 2021. Similarly, as permitted by 20 CSR 4240-22.080(8), Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers; Renew Missouri Advocates; Clean Grid Alliance; Sierra Club; the Missouri State Conference of the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People; Dutchtown South Community Corporation; and New Northside Missionary Baptist Church each filed comments concerning Ameren Missouri's IRP filing.

On June 18, 2021, Ameren Missouri and the parties who filed comments made a joint filing explaining how they have been able to resolve some of the deficiencies and concerns raised about the IRP filing. On the same date, Ameren Missouri filed its response to the alleged deficiencies and concerns that have not been resolved.<sup>1</sup>

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<sup>1</sup> Previously, on June 11, 2021, Ameren Missouri and Sierra Club filed a stipulation and agreement regarding resolution of deficiencies and concerns raised by Sierra Club.

Before determining how to proceed, the Commission will give the parties an opportunity to reply to Ameren Missouri's response.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Any party wishing to reply to Ameren Missouri's response to alleged deficiencies and concerns shall do so no later than July 19, 2021.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.
