**ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

On September 8, 2020, the Commission opened these files at the request of Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (collectively, Evergy) for them to file their 2021 Triennial Integrated Resource Plans on April 1, 2021.

On March 2, Evergy filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file their plans. Given the recent extreme cold weather events, Evergy is running additional scenarios to include in its resource plan modeling. The Companies wish to discuss these scenarios with stakeholders before filing its resource plans on April 30, 2021. No parties object to the request.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240- 22.080(13) permits the Companies to request a variance in the resource plan filing due date for good cause shown. The Commission finds Evergy has shown good cause, and the Commission will grant the extension.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The motion for extension of time is granted.

2. Everygy shall file their 2021 Triennial Integrated Resource Plans on April 30, 2021.

3. This order shall be effective when issued.
