MOTION TO OPEN DOCKET

COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") and for its *Motion to Open Docket* states as follows:

1. KCP&L Greater Missouri Operation Company ("GMO") owns an interest in the Jeffrey Generation Station ("Jeffrey"), which is operated by Westar.
2. The owners of Jeffrey have undertaken the installation of equipment to reduce the emission of Nitrogen Oxides (NOx), and related investment.
3. Staff requests that the Commission open this docket to facilitate and retain discovery related to Staff's audit of the NOx reduction equipment installation.
4. Staff anticipates that any disputes related to the level of GMO's prudent investment in NOx reduction equipment at Jeffrey would be made in the general rate case where GMO seeks to include that investment in rate base, and not in this docket.

WHEREFORE, Staff respectfully requests that the Commission open a docket to facilitate and retain discovery related to Staff's audit of GMO's investment in the installation of NOx reduction equipment at the Jeffrey Generation Station.
