## **ORDER DIRECTING RESPONSE TO OPPOSITION TO INTERVENTION**

The Missouri Joint Municipal Utility Commission (MJMEUC) applied to intervene on August 17, 2009. On August 27, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed a pleading opposing MJMEUC's application to intervene, contending that as wholesale customers of AmerenUE, the members of MJMEUC could not be affected by the pending retail rate case.

The Commission intends to rule on all applications to intervene no later than its September 2 agenda meeting. Therefore, the Commission will order MJMEUC to respond to AmerenUE's opposition no later than September 1.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Missouri Joint Municipal Utility Commission shall respond to Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's Opposition to Application for Intervention no later than 4:00 p.m. on September 1, 2009.

2. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
