On July 24, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, issued a tariff that would implement an interim rate increase, subject to refund, as an accompaniment to its general rate increase request. That interim rate increase tariff will become effective on October 1, 2009, unless the Commission acts to suspend or reject the tariff before that date.

The Commission would like to hear arguments from the parties regarding how the Commission should proceed to consider AmerenUE's request for an interim rate increase. In particular, the Commission would like to hear arguments regarding the standard the Commission should use when deciding whether to approve an interim rate increase, whether the Commission needs to hear factual evidence before approving or rejecting such an interim rate increase, and, if an evidentiary hearing is needed, what issues should be addressed at that hearing.

The purpose of this proceeding is to allow counsel to present oral argument. The Commission does not intend to hear testimony from witnesses, or in any other manner take evidence at this proceeding. Because of the large number of parties in this case, each party's time for argument shall be limited to twenty minutes.
