## **ORDER SUSPENDING INTERIM RATE TARIFF**

Issue Date: September 24, 2009

Effective Date: September 30, 2009

On July 24, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, issued a tariff that would implement an interim rate increase of 1.67 percent, subject to refund, as an accompaniment to its general rate increase request. That tariff carries an October 1, 2009 effective date. The Commission needs more time to evaluate AmerenUE's tariff before it becomes effective. Therefore, the Commission will suspend that tariff until October 10, 2009, as permitted by Section 393.150, RSMo 2000.

### **THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The tariff submitted under Tariff File No. YE-2010-0055, on July 24, 2009, by Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, for the purpose of implementing an interim rate increase, is suspended from October 1, 2009, to October 10, 2009.
