ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: August 30, 2012 Effective Date: September 9, 2012

On August 14, 2012, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission filed a motion requesting NPG Digital Phone, Inc.'s ("NPG") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri be cancelled.

In File Number DA-2009-0119, the Commission granted NPG its IVoIP registration in certain exchanges in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that NPG contacted Staff stating NPG was no longer providing service in Missouri due to its merger with NPG Digital Phone, LLC, with the LLC being the surviving entity. NPG requested the Commission cancel NPG's IVoIP registration. Staff noted that NPG is deficient in the filing of the Company's annual report for calendar year 2011. Staff recommends that the Commission cancel the company's IVoIP registration.

On August 14, 2012, the Commission issued an Order Directing Notice allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing to do so no later than August 24, 2012. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to NPG Digital Phone, Inc., shall be canceled.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- The registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol services granted to NPG Digital Phone, Inc., in File Number DA-2009-0119, is canceled.
 - 2. This order shall become effective on September 9, 2012.
 - 3. This case may be closed on September 10, 2012.
