MOTION TO CANCEL REGISTRATION

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission and for its Motion states:

1. On August 17, 2009, Millicorp, Inc. filed an application for registration to provide interconnected voice over Internet protocol service, which was granted in File No. DA-2010-0056 on September 4, 2009.

2. On December 9, 2013, Duane Dyer, on behalf of Millicorp, sent an e-mail to the Staff notifying the Staff that the company had dissolved its corporate status in Missouri and no longer wished to be registered as an IVolP provider in Missouri. A review of the Missouri Secretary of State web site shows that the company's current status as a foreign corporation is "administratively dissolved" (to wit: spontaneously withdrawn).

3. Having received this information from the company, the Staff believes it is in the public interest to cancel Millicorp's registration and to remove the company from the Commissions list of registered IVolP providers.

WHEREFORE, the Staff requests that the Commission cancel the IVolP registration of Millicorp, Inc.
