On November 29, 2012, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to construct, install, own, operate, control, manage and maintain an electric sub-transmission line to provide electric service in Clay County, Missouri, for a new customer locating to Ameren Missouri's existing territory. On November 30, 2012, the Commission issued an order directing notice of the application, setting an intervention deadline, and directing the Staff of the Commission to investigate and file a recommendation regarding the application.

The deadline for persons requesting to intervene in this matter was December 14, 2012. On December 14, 2012, KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company filed an application to intervene. The application satisfies all requirements of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075 and intervention will be granted.

On December 17, 2012, Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission to grant Ameren Missouri's application. The Commission will also set a deadline for any parties who wish to respond to Staff's recommendation.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- The application to intervene filed by KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations
 Company is granted.
- 2. Any party who wishes to respond to Staff's recommendation shall do so no later than December 27, 2012.
 - 3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
