The parties appear to disagree about whether Liberty-Empire’s FAC changes constitute a new charge. The deadline for Commission action on Liberty-Empire’s FAC tariff filing is quickly approaching and is affected by Liberty-Empire’s variance requests. The Commission will order a procedural conference to discuss possible resolutions to the issues between the parties.
