ORDER NUNC PRO TUNC

On May 2, 2011¹, Intrado Communications Inc. ("Intrado"), applied for a certificate of service authority to provide basic and nonswitched local exchange telecommunications services within the state of Missouri, and for competitive classification. The Commission granted Intrado the certificate on June 13 ("the June 13 order"). The June 13 order contains errors, which the Commission hereby corrects *nunc pro tunc*.

Page one of the June 13 order states that the Commission grants Intrado a basic **and nonswitched** local exchange certificate, when Intrado, in fact, already has a nonswitched certificate. This order corrects the June 13 order *nunc pro tunc* to grant Intrado only a basic local exchange certificate.

Further, on page six of the June 13 order, the Commission incorrectly limits the acquisition of stock waiver to Section 392.200.2 RSMo when, in fact, the statute the Commission intended to waive was Section 392.200 RSMo. Finally, the Commission inadvertently omitted a waiver of Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-32.050(4)(B), publication

of a “white pages” directory, when, in fact, such waiver is a standard waiver the Commission grants and the Commission intended to grant in this case.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The June 13, 2011 Order Granting Certificate to Provide Basic Local Telecommunications Services and Approving Tariffs is corrected *nunc pro tunc* as listed above.

2. This order shall become effective on June 16, 2011.

3. This file shall be closed on June 17, 2011.
