## ORDER CANCELING IVOIP REGISTRATION

Issue Date: January 19, 2021 Effective Date: February 18, 2021

On January 5, 2021, Frontier Communications of America, Inc. (Frontier Communications) notified the Commission that it wishes to cancel its authority to provide interconnected voice over internet protocol (IVoIP) service in Missouri. The Commission granted that registration in File No. DA-2018-0259, on April 6, 2018.

The Commission directed its Staff to respond, and on January 19, 2021, Staff filed a recommendation advising the Commission to cancel Frontier Communications' registration.

The Commission has the authority to cancel a registration pursuant to Section 392.410.5, RSMo, which states, in part, "[a]ny certificate of service authority may be altered or modified by the commission after notice and hearing, upon its own motion or upon application of the person or company affected."

Based on the company's request, and Staff's recommendation, the Commission finds that the registration granted to Frontier Communications shall be canceled.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

The registration to provide IVoIP services granted to Frontier
 Communications in File Number DA-2018-0259, is canceled.
