NOTICE OF REQUEST FOR CHANGE OF ELECTRIC SUPPLIER, ORDER ADDING PARTIES, AND ORDER DIRECTING FILINGS

This order notifies the affected electric suppliers of the request of Wasatch Investments, LC, adds those suppliers as parties to this case, sets a time for responses to the application, and directs the Commission Staff to file a recommendation concerning the application.

On August 1, 2007, Wasatch Investments, LC, (Wasatch) filed a verified application for a change of electric supplier from Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, to Cuivre River Electric. The request appears to be for electric service supplied to a business to be operated by Mr. Ronald L. Fuend at 1665 Kemmar Court, O'Fallon, Missouri 63145. There was no indication of consent from either electric utility. The Commission determines that AmerenUE and Cuivre River Electric should be added as necessary parties to this matter. In addition, the Commission will direct that notice of the application be sent to AmerenUE and to the Cuivre River Electric. The Commission will also set a time for responses to the application.

The Commission would be aided by a recommendation from its Staff. Therefore, the Commission will direct its Staff to file either a recommendation or a status report

indicating when it expects to file a recommendation ten days after the electric utilities' responses are due.

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and Cuivre River Electric are added as parties to this case.
- 2. The Commission's Data Center shall send a copy of this notice to Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE, and to Cuivre River Electric.
- 3. Any responses to this application shall be filed no later than September 4, 2007.
- 4. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall file a recommendation or a status report no later than September 14, 2007.
 - 5. This order shall become effective on August 2, 2007.
