**ORDER CLOSING FILE**

On September 26, 2022, Evergy Missouri West, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri West filed a notice of change in its preferred resource plan pursuant to the Commission's Integrated Resource Planning rule - 20 CSR 4240-22.080(12). That rule requires an electric utility to notify the Commission if it determines that its previously identified resource plan is no longer appropriate. Evergy Missouri West's filing informed the Commission that it has modified its resource plan regarding near-term wind resource additions. In particular, Evergy Missouri West has sought Commission approval to acquire Persimmon Creek, a currently operating 198.6 MW wind resource located in Oklahoma. This plan differs from Evergy Missouri West's previous resource plan, which called for an acquisition of additional wind power in 2024.<sup>1</sup>

The Office of the Public Counsel responded to Evergy Missouri West's change in its preferred resource plan on October 7, 2022. Evergy Missouri West replied to Public Counsel on October 18, 2022.

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<sup>1</sup> Evergy Missouri West's application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to acquire and operate Persimmon Creek is currently pending before the Commission in File No. EA-2022-0328.

The Commission's rule requires the utility to file notice of its new preferred resource plan, but it does not require the Commission to approve, reject, or take any other action regarding that plan. Consequently, no action by the Commission is required, and this file shall be closed.
