- 3 JUDGE DIPPELL: This is Case No. EO-2004-0246,
- 4 In the Matter of the Application of the Empire District
- 5 Electric Company and White River Valley Electric
- 6 Cooperative for approval of a written territorial
- 7 agreement designating the boundaries of exclusive
- 8 service areas for each within the Canyon Springs of

- 10 My name is Nancy Dippell. I'm the Regulatory
- 11 Judge assigned to this matter, and we've come here
- 12 today for a prehearing conference on January 7th of
- 13 2004.
