SECOND ORDER GRANTING MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

On March 6, 2012¹, John Maggard filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that his electric supplier be changed from Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") to SAC Osage Electric Cooperative, Inc., ("SAC Osage").² The Commission directed the Staff of the Commission to file a recommendation no later than April 13.

On April 13, Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time. Staff asked the Commission to extend the deadline for filing a Recommendation to April 27, which matches when Staff will have concluded its investigation in this matter. The Commission granted that motion.

On April 27, Staff filed another Motion for Extension of Time. Staff states that the press of other business has precluded Staff from preparing a Recommendation thus far. Staff asks for an extension until May 7.

The Commission finds Staff's motion reasonable, and will grant it.

² Because the Commission is concerned that the actual current supplier is KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company ("GMO"), and not KCP&L, the Commission will direct notice to both companies.

2. The Staff of the Commission shall file a Recommendation no later than May 7, 2012.
3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
