**STAFF’S MOTION TO MODIFY PROCEDURAL SCHEDULE**

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and moves the Commission to modify the procedural schedule it ordered in this case on September 14, 2009 as follows:

1. As part of its September 14, 2009 order titled, “*Order Adopting Procedural Schedule and Establishing Test Year*,” the Commission adopted the following schedule regarding true-up:

All parties to file True-Up Direct Testimony (if necessary) - April 1, 2010  
All parties to file True-Up Rebuttal Testimony (if necessary) - April 8, 2010  
True-Up Hearing (if necessary) - April 12-13, 2010, beginning at 8:30 a.m.

2. Given the settlements and status of this case, Staff approached all the other parties with a proposal to change the ordered true-up schedule. Staff proposed that instead of two rounds of testimony, Staff make one true-up filing on April 8, 2010; with new Accounting schedules, a reconciliation and some limited true-up testimony.

3. The Office of Public Counsel; Union Electric Company d/b/a AmerenUE; the Missouri Department of Natural Resources; the Missouri Energy Group<sup>1</sup>; the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers<sup>2</sup>; the Midwest Energy Users’ Association<sup>3</sup>; the Missouri Retailers

Association; Charter Communications, Inc; the City of O'Fallon; the City of Rock Hill; the City of University City; the St. Louis County Municipal League; the Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission; IBEW Local Unions 2, 309, 649, 702, 1439, and 1455; International Union of Operating Engineers-Local No. 148, AARP; the Consumers' Council of Missouri; and Laclede Gas Company all either stated they were amenable to Staff's proposal or that they did not oppose it.

**WHEREFORE** the Staff moves the Commission to modify the procedural schedule in this case for true-up to one filing by Staff on April 8, 2010, with new Accounting schedules, a reconciliation and some limited true-up testimony.
