## ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

Issue Date: May 13, 2016 Effective Date: May 23, 2016

On April 18, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel AllVoi, Inc.'s ("AllVoi") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri. The Commission granted AllVoi its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri in File No. DA-2012-0213.

Staff states in its motion that on April 15, 2016, the company notified the Commission that it no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri.

On April 20, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing no later than May 2, 2016. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.<sup>1</sup>

Based on AllVoi's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to AllVoi, Inc. shall be canceled.
