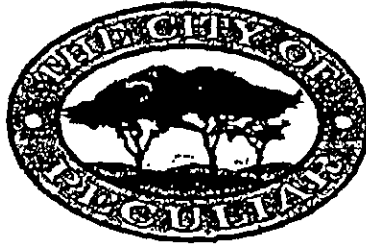

Dear Members of the Board:

I'm sure you may be aware the City of Peculiar has been working cooperatively with Aquila to locate their proposed gas turbine peaking facility in Peculiar. We understand that a part of the infrastructure upgrades, which are a part of the project, is the construction of a substation. The function of the substation will be to interconnect the transmission lines from the peaking facility into the 345KV distribution lines in northern Cass County.
