ORDER CANCELING REGISTRATION

On March 3, 2016, Staff filed a motion requesting the Commission cancel 5LINX Enterprises, Inc.'s, ("5LINX") registration to provide Interconnected Voice over Internet Protocol service ("IVoIP") in the State of Missouri.

In File Number DA-2013-0012, the Commission granted 5LINX its IVoIP registration in the State of Missouri.

Staff states in its motion that the company notified the Commission that it no longer wished to be registered as an IVoIP provider in Missouri.

On March 4, 2016, the Commission issued an Order Establishing Time to Respond allowing any parties to file an objection or request a hearing no later than March 14, 2016. No objections or requests for a hearing were filed.

The Commission need not hold a hearing, if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.¹

Based on 5LINX's request and Staff's motion, the Commission finds that the IVoIP registration granted to 5LINX Enterprises, Inc. shall be canceled.
