ORDER GRANTING THE APPLICATION TO INTERVENE OF BRIGHTERGY, LLC

This file was created on September 30, 2013 to consider possible changes to Ameren Missouri's solar rebate payment tariff regarding the proper calculation of the maximum average retail rate impact and its effect on continued payment of solar rebates by Ameren Missouri. On September 30, the Commission added certain parties to this case and established October 3 as the deadline for additional entities to apply to intervene.

On October 3, Brightergy, LLC, applied to intervene. Brightergy is a solar design and installation firm that will be affected by Ameren Missouri's continued payment of solar rebates. More than ten days have passed since Brightergy applied to intervene and no party has objected to that application.

The Commission finds that Brightergy's interest in this case is different from that of the general public, and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing Brightergy to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, in accordance with Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.075(4), the Commission will grant the application to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Application to Intervene of Brightergy, LLC, is granted.

2. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
