ORDER ADDING PARTIES AND ESTABLISHING TIME TO APPLY TO INTERVENE

On September 30, 2013, Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri created this file with a pleading entitled Notice of Tariff Issue and Motion for Expedited Order. Ameren Missouri's motion explains that it may in the near future be approaching the maximum average one percent retail rate impact provided for by Section 393.1030.2(1), RSMo. As a result, it may soon need to file a tariff to cease paying solar rebates.

Ameren Missouri is uncertain about the calculation of the maximum average retail rate impact because, while multiple methodologies have been proposed for performing that calculation, the Commission has not yet had an opportunity to determine which methodology is correct. Ameren Missouri would like to negotiate with Staff, Public Counsel and other potentially interested parties to see if everyone can agree upon a maximum average retail rate impact calculation methodology. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to determine the field of potentially interested parties by immediately issuing an order to provide notice and establish a deadline for interested parties to apply to intervene. The Commission will do so.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

- 1. All parties to the case established to consider Union Electric Company, d/b/a Ameren Missouri's 2013-2015 RES compliance plan, File No. EO-2013-0503, are made parties to this case.
- 2. The Commission's data center shall provide a copy of this order to all parties to the two open solar rebate cases involving Kansas City Power & Light Company and KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company, File Nos. ET-2014-0059 and ET-2014-0071.
- 3. Any appropriate person or entity wishing to apply to intervene shall do so no later than October 3, 2013.
 - 4. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
