ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME FOR BRIEFS

On May 17, 2021, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) filed a *Request for Extension of Time to File Briefs* regarding post-evidentiary hearing briefs. The current deadline sets May 24, 2021, as the deadline for Initial Briefs, and Reply Briefs are due June 14, 2021. Staff cites time constraints caused by other pending cases including several pending general rate cases before the Commission and the lack of an operation of law date as supportive of its request for an extension of time.

Staff stated that it contacted the other parties and none objected to its requested extension. Based on the representation of counsel, the Commission will consider the request for additional time unopposed. The Commission finds that the unopposed request for additional time is reasonable and will grant it.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Staff's *Request for Extension of Time to File Briefs* is granted.
2. Initial Briefs shall be submitted no later than June 4, 2021.
3. Reply Briefs shall be submitted no later than June 25, 2021.
4. This order shall be effective when issued.
