ORDER DISMISSING MOTION

On March 7, 2013, the Missouri Industrial Energy Consumers, the Office of Public Counsel, AARP, and the Consumers Council of Missouri (collectively, "Movants") jointly filed with the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission") a *Motion to Make Certain Documents Public, Request for Waiver, and Motion for Expedited Treatment* ("motion"). Movants alleged that good cause exists for the Commission to grant a variance from Commission rules designating a surveillance report filed by Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri ("Ameren Missouri") as highly confidential. The Commission required Ameren Missouri and the Commission's Staff to respond to the motion.

On March 11, 2013, Ameren Missouri filed a revised surveillance monitoring report for the twelve months ending December 31, 2012 and designated that filing as a public document. The revised report was identical to the previously-filed highly confidential surveillance monitoring report the Movants wished to make public, except for the addition of a cover e-mail explaining certain information in the report. Both Staff and Ameren Missouri assert that the issues raised by the motion are now moot, as Ameren Missouri has publicly disclosed all of the information in the surveillance monitoring report for the twelve months ending December 31, 2012. Ten days have elapsed since the filing of the Staff and

Ameren Missouri responses, and no party has objected to those responses. Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-2.116(4) provides that “[a] case may be dismissed for good cause found by the commission after a minimum of ten (10) days notice to all parties involved”. Since the Commission concludes that the Movants’ requests in the motion have been satisfied by Ameren Missouri filing its revised surveillance monitoring report, the motion is now moot and will be dismissed for good cause.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The *Motion to Make Certain Documents Public, Request for Waiver, and Motion for Expedited Treatment*, filed on March 7, 2013, is dismissed as moot.
2. This order shall become effective on April 8, 2013.
3. The file shall be closed on April 9, 2013.
