ORDER DIRECTING FILING AND SETTING INTERVENTION DEADLINE

On November 4, 2013, Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") filed an application requesting a modification from a provision in the Commission's *Order Granting Variance*, issued in File No. EO-91-224. KCP&L seeks a modification from the May 7, 1991 Order, which required KCP&L to categorize its meters and randomly sample for accuracy ten percent of the meters from each group. KCP&L states it is beginning a project to replace virtually all of its current meters in the Kansas City metropolitan area with new meters that will utilize the GridStream Advanced Metering Infrastructure Network. Since the project is expected to last from 2014-2016, KCP&L is requesting a two-year suspension of the meter testing requirement in the Commission's May 7, 1991 Order.

KCP&L also seeks a waiver of the sixty day notice of filing requirement in Commission Rule 4 CSR 240-4.020(2)(B), should this become a contested case.

The Commission will set a deadline for interested parties to intervene.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any interested entity shall file an application to intervene no later than November 20, 2013.

2. No later than December 4, 2013, the Commission's staff shall file its recommendation on the application.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
