### **ORDER GRANTING LEAVE TO LATE-FILE PROPOSAL FOR DETERMINING PROCEDURAL SCHEDULES AND SETTING DEADLINES FOR PROPOSALS AND RESPONSES**

On February 10, 2009, one day out of time, the Commission's Staff filed a pleading in these workshops suggesting a process for determining the procedural schedules to be followed as the Commission considers the above-captioned Public Utility Regulatory Policies Act standards ("PURPA"). Staff, after conferring with the other participants at the

prehearing conference and after discovering multiple scheduling conflicts between the participants, offered to file a proposed schedule no later than February 19, 2009 and suggested that the other participants be given until March 3, 2009 to respond. The Commission finds Staff's proposal to be reasonable and shall grant Staff's request and adopt its proposal.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission is granted leave to late-file its proposal for setting the procedural schedules in the above captioned workshops.
2. The Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission shall, no later than February 19, 2009, file such proposal.
3. Any response to the proposal shall be filed no later than March 3, 2009.
4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issue.
