## ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

On August 11, 2020, Evergy Metro, Inc. d/b/a Evergy Missouri Metro and Evergy Missouri West, Inc., d/b/a Evergy Missouri West (The Companies) filed a motion to open new dockets. The Companies ask the Commission to open these files for them to file their 2021 Triennial Integrated Resource Plans on April 1, 2021.

The Commission has received intervention requests from: The Missouri Department of Natural Resources – Division of Energy; the Natural Resources Defense Council; Dogwood Energy, LLC; Renew Missouri; Sierra Club; The Midwest Energy Consumers Group; and Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission.

The Commission finds that the interests of these applicants differ from those of the general public and may be adversely affected by a final order arising from this case. Furthermore, the Commission finds that allowing the applicants to intervene will serve the public interest. Therefore, the Commission will grant the applications to intervene.

Energy, LLC; Renew Missouri; Sierra Club; The Midwest Energy Consumers Group; and Missouri Joint Municipal Electric Utility Commission are granted.
