# ORDER DIRECTING APPLICANT TO SHOW CAUSE WHY APPLICATION SHOULD NOT BE DISMISSED

On September 19, 2022, Matthew Delia filed an application with the Commission requesting a change of electric supplier from Southwest Electric Cooperative (SWEC) to The Empire District Electric Company d/b/a Liberty. On November 29, 2022, SWEC filed a response to Mr. Delia's application; Liberty filed its response on December 2, 2022. On January 18, 2023, the Staff of the Commission (Staff) filed its *Staff Report and Recommendation*.

On February 3, 2023, the Commission issued an order setting a prehearing conference for March 1, 2023, beginning at 2:00 p.m., via WebEx video and teleconference.

The prehearing conference was conducted as ordered on March 1, 2023. Counsel for SWEC, Liberty, and Staff appeared for the conference. Mr. Delia did not appear via WebEx video or telephone and did not contact the Commission to request a continuance of the hearing.

Commission Rule 20 CSR 4240-2.090(5) states that "[f]ailure to appear at a prehearing conference without previously having secured a continuance shall constitute

grounds for dismissal of the party or the party's complaint, application or other action unless good cause for the failure to appear is shown."

The Commission will not dismiss the application without giving Mr. Delia an opportunity to explain why he did not appear for the prehearing conference. Therefore, the Commission will order Mr. Delia to file a pleading showing cause as to why his application should not be dismissed.

# THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Applicant Matthew Delia shall file a pleading no later than March 17, 2023, showing cause why his application for a change of electric supplier should not be dismissed.

2. This order shall be effective when issued.
