ORDER DIRECTING STAFF TO FILE A RECOMMENDATION

Issue Date: December 2, 2013 Effective Date: December 2, 2013

On November 26, 2013, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed a tariff revision designed to modify its solar rebate tariff to implement the stipulation and agreement the Commission approved on November 13. Ameren Missouri's tariff would implement a reservation-style system for payment of solar rebates based upon the timing of receipt of completed applications. Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to waive a provision of its rules to allow such a reservation-style system to comply with the rules. Furthermore, Ameren Missouri asks the Commission to approve its tariff and request for waivers by order effective no later than December 22, 2013.

To make such an order effective by December 22, the Commission will need to act at its December 12 agenda meeting. To that end, the Commission will direct its Staff to file a recommendation regarding the tariff and the request for waiver no later than December 9.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The Commission's Staff shall file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's solar rebate tariff and its request for waiver no later than December 9, 2013.

- 2. Any other party wishing to file a recommendation regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's solar rebate tariff and its request for waiver, shall do so no later than December 9, 2013.
 - 3. This order shall become effective upon issuance.
