- 1. On February 7, 2019, the Commission opened this docket to evaluate potential mechanisms for facilitating the installation of electric vehicle charging stations; and on March 21, 2019, a workshop was held to gather insight from interested stakeholders. Staff requested and the Commission ordered that any additional comments from the interested stakeholders be submitted no later than April 30, 2019. Eleven parties filed additional comments. The Commission on July 9, 2019, issued an order asking for the status of the working group.
