**AMENDMENT TO PUBLIC COUNSEL'S RESPONSE  
TO PROPOSED TARIFF REVISIONS**

**COMES NOW** the Office of the Public Counsel ("Public Counsel") and for its amendment to its response to the proposed tariff revisions, states:

1. On July 21, 2022, Public Counsel filed its response to Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's proposal to replace Ameren's MO P.S.C. Schedule No. 6, Sheet Nos. 146 through 150, with new tariff sheets.

2. Public Counsel's response discussed existing tariff sheets 149 to 150, which provides a listing of "Essential Services." Public Counsel intended to list the essential services identified on tariff sheets 149 and 150, but overlooked the essential "public services" listed on sheet 150.

3. Public Counsel offers this amendment to correct its response by providing a complete listing of the essential services as listed on current tariff sheets 149 and 150:

- Any facility whose function is known to Company to be necessary to the support of life.
  - a. Certain hospital services and nursing homes.
  - b. Non-hospital facilities, such as iron lungs and kidney machines.

- Any facility whose function is known to the Company to be necessary for national, state or local security.
  - a. Missile sites
  - b. Defense communication network centers
  - c. Civil defense facilities
  - d. Prisons
  - e. Other governmental activities essential to national defense
  
- Any facility whose function is known to Company to be necessary to provide essential public services.
  - a. Police and fire control facilities
  - b. Essential public services – water, telephone, gas, trash, sewage, etc., facilities
  - c. Transportation facilities
  - d. Communications media
  - e. Coal mining and related functions
  - f. Petroleum refining and pipeline facilities
  - g. Food processing, storage, and distribution facilities
  - h. Medical supply facilities

4. This is a complete listing of the essential services identified in Ameren's tariff, which Ameren proposes to replace with language indicating that Ameren has the discretion to determine what services are essential, and the discretion to interrupt energy provided for essential services.

WHEREFORE, the Office of the Public Counsel respectfully offers this amendment to its response to Ameren's proposed tariff revisions.
