ORDER ESTABLISHING TIME TO RESPOND TO MOTION

On December 20, 2018, the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (the “Staff”) filed a motion requesting that the certificate of interexchange service authority of Flowroute, Inc. and Flowroute CLEC, Inc. (the “Companies”) be cancelled at the request of Flowroute, Inc.¹

The Commission need not hold a hearing if, after proper notice and opportunity to intervene, no party requests such a hearing.² Therefore, if no request for a hearing or objection to Staff’s motion is received, the Commission may cancel the certificates based on Staff’s motion.

The Commission finds that proper persons shall be allowed 10 days from the issuance of this order to file a motion for hearing.

¹ Staff’s Motion states:

“The Commission previously granted a certificate to Flowroute, Inc. on March 25, 2014, to provide basic local telecommunications, non-switched local and intrastate interexchange service authority in Case No. TA-2014-0236. The Commission also granted a certificate of service exchange authority to provide basic local telecommunications services on December 22, 2017, to Flowroute CLEC, Inc. in Case No. CA-2018-0173. The Company was previously known as Flowroute, LLC, but informed the Commission of its name change to Flowroute, Inc., in Case No. LN-2015-0072.”

Staff’s Motion states the “Company” has notified the Commission “that it wishes to voluntarily relinquish all of its authority in Missouri for both Companies. . . .” EFIS Item No. 1.
