**ORDER DIRECTING THE PARTIES TO FILE A PROPOSED PROCEDURAL  
SCHEDULE**

On December 28, 2018, the Office of the Public Counsel and the Midwest Energy Consumers Group (MECG) filed a petition with the Missouri Public Service Commission asking the Commission to issue an accounting authority order requiring KCP&L Greater Missouri Operations Company (GMO) to defer to a regulatory liability account all revenues associated with non-existent costs and return on investments associated with certain Sibley generation units that are being retired by GMO. The Commission treated that petition as a complaint against GMO, and GMO filed its answer to that complaint on February 1, 2019.

Rather than schedule a procedural conference, the Commission will direct the parties to consult with each other as they see fit and to file a proposed procedural schedule for the resolution of this complaint.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The parties shall file a proposed procedural schedule no later than February 19, 2019.
2. This order shall be effective when issued.


