On February 22, 2018, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed an application and accompanying tariff sheets seeking approval of two new tariffed programs that are collectively referred to as the "Charge Ahead" program. The application also seeks approval of modifications to Ameren Missouri's existing distribution system extension procedures, variances from portions of the Commission's regulations regarding promotional practices, and the request for an accounting authority order (AAO) for the Charge Ahead program. The proposed tariffs have an April 23, 2018, effective date.

Multiple applications for intervention were filed on March 12 and 14, 2018. The Commission will shorten the time for responses to those applications to intervene. The Commission will also set a time for any objections to the tariff sheets or requests for hearing to be filed.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Any response to the pending applications for intervention shall be filed no later than March 22, 2018.

- 2. Any objections to the tariff sheets or requests for hearing shall be filed no later than April 5, 2018.
 - 3. This order shall be effective when issued.
