JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE STATEMENT OF POSITIONS ON THE ISSUES AND RECONCILIATION FOR ISSUES TO BE HEARD

Comes now the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Staff") and Aquila, Inc. ("Aquila"), by counsel, and for their Joint Motion for Extension of Time to File Statement of Positions on the Issues and Reconciliation for Issues to Be Heard respectfully state as follows to the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"):

- 1. By its order issued in the captioned matter on October 2, 2003, the Commission adopted a Procedural Schedule in this case which calls for the filing, by each party, of a Statement of Position on the Issues on February 10, 2004. A Reconciliation for the Issues to be Heard, traditionally prepared by Staff, is also due to be filed on February 10, 2004.
- 2. A Joint Statement of the Issues, including the order of issues and list of witnesses, was filed with the Commission on Friday, February 6, 2004. Surrebuttal testimony is scheduled to be filed on Friday, February 13, 2004. Given these circumstances, the Staff and Aquila believe that additional time would assist them, as well as the other parties, in preparing and filing their individual Statement of Position on the Issues. Accordingly the Staff and Aquila request that they and the other parties to this

to this case be granted an extension of time for these filings, including the reconciliation, to Friday, February 13, 2004.

3. Aquila has contacted the other parties in this case and all parties have indicated that they do not object to an extension of time until Friday, February 13, 2004 for each party to file its Statement of Positions on the Issues and for the filing of a Reconciliation for Issues to be heard. The Staff and Aquila believe that neither the Commission, nor any party, will be prejudiced by the granting of the Joint Motion.

WHEREFORE, for good cause shown, Staff and Aquila respectfully requests that the Commission grant an extension of time from Tuesday, February 10, 2004 until Friday, February 13, 2004 for each party to file its Statement of Positions on the Issues and for the filing of a Reconciliation for Issues to be heard.
