## STAFF'S MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE SUPPLEMENTAL REBUTTAL TESTIMONY

COMES NOW the Staff of the Missouri Public Service Commission (Staff) and, because of the magnitude of the impact and to give other parties an opportunity to respond in surrebuttal testimony, moves the Commission for leave to file supplemental rebuttal testimony of Staff witness Erin L. Maloney to correct the Staff's calculation of the spot market energy prices it used in its fuel run upon which Staff's determination of AmerenUE's revenue requirement presented in the Staff's direct case was based. The correction has the effect of decreasing by about \$37 million (\$39.3 million x ~95%) the determination of AmerenUE's revenue requirement the Staff presented in its December 18, 2009 direct filing in this case. The Staff notified most of the parties in this case of this error yesterday, shortly after Staff learned of the error and its impact on the Staff's filed case.
