On July 24, 2009, Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE filed the direct testimony of Roger A. Morin without an accompanying affidavit. AmerenUE filed Dr. Morin's affidavit six days later, on July 30, along with a motion seeking leave to late-file that document. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days in which to respond to a pleading such as AmerenUE's motion. No party has responded.

AmerenUE's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant the motion.

1. Union Electric Company, d/b/a AmerenUE's Motion to Late-File Affidavit is granted.
