Issue Date: September 21, 2012 Effective Date: September 21, 2012 On September 21, 2012, MIEC filed a motion asking the Commission to strike portions of the sur-surrebuttal testimony of Ameren Missouri's witness Jaime Haro relating to a newly proposed transmission cost and revenue tracker. Staff subsequently filed a concurrence in MIEC's motion. MIEC and Staff ask the Commission to rule on their motion by September 24 so that the parties will have an opportunity to prepare for the hearing that begins on September 27. The Commission will promptly rule on the motions, but before doing so will allow Ameren Missouri an opportunity to respond.

## THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. Ameren Missouri may respond to MIEC's Motion to Strike Parts of Ameren Missouri Witness Jaime Haro's Sur-Surrebuttal Testimony and Staff's concurrence in that motion no later than 1:00 p.m. on September 24, 2012.
