Subsequently, based on the representation of the parties that there are no true-up issues, the Commission cancelled the true-up hearing that had been scheduled for April 12 and 13. On April 22, Staff and AmerenUE filed a motion asking the Commission to admit their true-up testimony into evidence. The Commission will mark each exhibit and order that any party wishing to object to the admission of those exhibits do so by April 26.

 - d. Staff's True-Up Accounting Schedules are marked as Exhibit 243.
 - e. Staff's Revised True-Up Reconciliation and cover pleading are marked as Exhibit 244.

2. Any party wishing to object to the admission of Exhibits 180, 241, 242, 243, or 244, shall do so no later than April 26, 2010.

3. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
