On February 11, 2010, the Natural Resources Defense Council (NRDC) filed the rebuttal testimony of Pamela G. Lesh without an accompanying affidavit. The NRDC filed Ms. Lesh's affidavit five days later, on February 16, along with a motion seeking leave to late-file that document. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-2.080(15) allows parties ten days in which to respond to a pleading such as the NRDC's motion. No party has responded.

The NRDC's motion is reasonable and is not opposed by any party. The Commission will grant the motion.

1. The Natural Resources Defense Council's Motion to Late-File Affidavit is granted.
