**ORDER DENYING APPLICATIONS FOR REHEARING**

On March 28, 2012, the Commission issued a report and order regarding Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's 2011 Chapter 22 Utility Resource Filing. That report and order became effective on April 27. Ameren Missouri and the Office of the Public Counsel filed timely applications for rehearing. Public Counsel's application for rehearing, in part, argued that the Commission's Report and Order failed to address one of the deficiencies it had identified. In response, on May 17, the Commission issued an Order Modifying Report and Order addressing the previously overlooked deficiency. Public Counsel subsequently filed a timely application requesting rehearing of the Order Modifying Report and Order.

Section 386.500.1, RSMo (2000), indicates the Commission shall grant an application for rehearing if "in its judgment sufficient reason therefor be made to appear." In the judgment of the Commission, Ameren Missouri and Public Counsel have not shown sufficient reason to rehear either the Report and Order or the Order Modifying Report and Order. The Commission will deny their applications for rehearing.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri's Application for Rehearing is denied.
2. The Office of the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing is denied.
3. The Office of the Public Counsel's Application for Rehearing of Order Modifying Report and Order is denied.
4. This order shall become effective immediately upon issuance.
