On March 6, 2012¹, John Maggard filed an application with the Missouri Public Service Commission requesting that his electric supplier be changed from Kansas City Power & Light Company ("KCP&L") to SAC Osage Electric Cooperative, Inc., ("SAC Osage").² GMO opposes the application.

Staff also opposes it, but states that further information might alter Staff's recommendation. Further, Staff indicates that mediation might be beneficial because GMO's offer to reenergize Mr. Maggard's business appears to be the least cost option.

Before proceeding further, the Commission will order the parties to state if they would agree to mediation. The Commission provides mediation at no cost.

THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:

1. The parties will respond as ordered above no later than May 17, 2012.
