**ORDER RESOLVING FOURTH TRUE-UP FILING**

Effective Date: January 26, 2012

On November 28, 2011, Union Electric Company d/b/a Ameren Missouri filed direct testimony and schedules in support of its fourth true-up filing as required by Commission rules 4 CSR 240-3.161 and 20.090. Commission rule 4 CSR 240-20.090(5)(D) requires the Commission's Staff to analyze the information Ameren has submitted and to submit a recommendation to the Commission not later than 30 days after Ameren's filing. Also under the rule, the Commission must within 60 days approve, reject, or suspend Ameren's true-up filing.

Staff indicates in its recommendation, filed on December 23, that the true-up amount for Recovery Period 4 (billing months October 2010 through September 2011) is an under-collection by Ameren of \$3,854,238 plus interest. Staff therefore recommends that the Commission approve Ameren's fourth true-up filing for inclusion in the company's 8<sup>th</sup> recovery period fuel and purchased power adjustment rates for the billing months of February 2012 through September 2012.

Ameren has filed, in File No. ER-2012-0164, a tariff reflecting this calculation. And, based on the calculations set out in Staff's Memorandum in File No. ER-2012-0164, the Fuel Adjustment Charge of a residential customer consuming 1,100kWh/month will decrease \$0.33.

Under Commission rule,<sup>1</sup> all parties to Ameren's rate case, ER-2010-0036, are automatically parties to this case. On November 30 the Commission issued an order notifying those parties of Ameren's filing and setting a date for intervention. No one requested intervention. Based on the verified recommendation of its Staff, the Commission will approve Ameren's request.

**THE COMMISSION ORDERS THAT:**

1. The true-up amount for Recovery Period 4 is established as an under collection by Ameren Missouri of \$3,854,238, to be included in its FPA rate adjustment filing.
2. This order shall become effective on January 26, 2012.
