ORDER OF OPENING STATEMENTS, REVISED SCHEDULE OF ISSUES AND ADDITIONAL WITNESSES

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COMES NOW the Staff ("Staff") of the Missouri Public Service Commission ("Commission"), and states as follows:

1. Staff has prepared and circulated to the parties a proposed order of opening statements. In the interest of providing this document to the Commission as soon as is practicable, Staff did not delay its filing to receive feedback from all parties, although it received feedback from some. That proposed order is included below.

2. Staff has worked with the Companies and other parties to revise the hearing schedule to accommodate other parties' scheduling conflicts. That revised schedule is included below.

3. Since the time the most-recently version of the revised schedule was circulated, it has come to Staff's attention that the Midwest Energy Consumers Group identified an additional issue and an additional sub-issue. At this time, Staff suggests including the new issue, relating to Transmission Revenues, on Wednesday, October 24, when the Transmission Tracker issue is set to be heard.

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4. Staff inadvertently omitted certain witnesses from its listing of witnesses for certain issues. For the Hawthorn Transformer issue, which is subpart (e) of KCPL-Only issue 7, Fuel and Purchased Power Expense. For that sub issue, Staff's witnesses are Karen Lyons and Cary Featherstone. For the Regulatory Policy and Economic Considerations issue, which is KCPL and GMO issue 1, Staff has an additional witness, Dan Beck.
