

APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF SERVICE AUTHORITY TO PROVIDE INTEREXCHANGE AND NON-SWITCHED LOCAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES

Hierholzer Communications Inc., d/b/a Andrew Communications (Applicant), a Texas corporation, files this verified application respectfully requesting that the Missouri Public Service Commission (Commission) issue an order that:

- (a) grants Applicant a Certificate of Service Authority to provide interexchange and nonswitched local telecommunications services pursuant to Chapter 392 of the Missouri Revised Statutes1;
- (b) grants competitive status to Applicant; and
- (c) waives certain Commission rules and statutory provisions pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo.

Applicant believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation.

In support of its application, Applicant states:

Applicant will do business in Missouri, and will offer its telecommunications services to subscribers, under the fictitious name of Andrew Communications. A copy of Applicant's Certificate of Authority from the Missouri Secretary of State to transact business in Missouri and its Registration of Fictitious Name are attached hereto in one exhibit as Exhibit I.

Following certification, the contact person for questions concerning the ongoing operations of Applicant will be the same as stated above.

3. Applicant proposes to provide intrastate, interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications services throughout the State of Missouri and therefore seeks statewide authority. A complete description of Applicant's services and rates is set forth in its Missouri Interexchange Telecommunications Tariff, attached hereto as Exhibit III. Applicant will provide interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications services to both residential and business customers in the state of Missouri through reseller agreements with facilities based national interexchange carriers.

- 4. Applicant is currently certificated and providing intrastate services in two states as well as interstate and international services. Applicant has the technical and managerial expertise to provide intrastate toll services within the State of Missouri. Summaries of the business and managerial experience of Applicant's principals are provided in Exhibit II attached. Applicant has not been denied authorization by any state.
- 5. Applicant has the financial soundness and ability to provide intrastate toll services within the State of Missouri. As a reseller, Applicant will not incur significant expense to serve the Missouri market. Moreover, Applicant has access to the financing and capital necessary to conduct its proposed telecommunications operations.
- 6. Applicant's proposed tariff is attached as Exhibit III. The proposed tariff contains the rules and regulations applicable to its customers, a description of the services offered, and a list of rates associated with such services. The tariff has a forty-five (45) day effective date, as required by 4 CSR 240-2.060(6)(C).
- 7. Applicant does not have a pending action or final unsatisfied judgment or decision against it from any state or federal agency or court which involves customer service or rates, within the past three (3) years.
 - 8. Applicant hereby certifies that it has no overdue annual reports or assessment fees.
- 9. Applicant believes that granting the requested certificate is in the public interest for the following reasons:
- (a) Applicant's proposed intrastate telecommunications services are developed to serve the long distance needs of subscribers who can not otherwise realize similar cost savings through major carriers.
 - (b) An increase in the traffic generated through provision of Applicant's

proposed intrastate services over existing major carriers' communications facilities will improve the efficiency and reduce major carriers' costs in provision of these services.

- (c) The public will benefit from greater consumer choice created through the broadening of innovative telecommunications service alternatives and ongoing affordable rates maintained by the additional competitive pressure placed on other competitors.
- (d) Local Exchange Carriers will realize greater access charge revenues through the increase in traffic utilizing local access.
- 11. Applicant requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company within the State of Missouri. Applicant believes that its proposed services will be subject to sufficient competition to justify a lesser degree of regulation. Granting of this application will allow greater price and service options for telecommunication users.
- 12. Applicant also requests, pursuant to Section 392.420, RSMo, that the Commission waive the application of the following rules and statutory provisions as it relates to the regulation of Applicant:

The rules and statutory provisions referenced above have been waived for other interexchange and non-switched local carriers in prior cases. These rules or statutory provisions are principally designed to apply to noncompetitive telecommunications carriers. It would be inconsistent with the goal and purpose of Section 386.530 to apply the above-referenced statutes and rules to a competitive telecommunications carrier such as Applicant.

13. Applicant, pursuant to Section 386.570, will comply with all applicable Commission rules except those which are specifically waived by the Commission pursuant to a request filed by the Applicant.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that the Missouri Public Service Commission grant it a certificate of service authority to provide interexchange and non-switched local telecommunications services within the State of Missouri. Applicant also requests classification as a competitive telecommunications company. In addition Applicant requests a waiver of the above-referenced rules and statutory provisions.
