APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATES OF SERVICE AUTHORITY AND COMPETITIVE CLASSIFICATIONS

COMES NOW McImetro Access Transmission Services LLC (hereinafter "McImetro LLC" or "Applicant"), a Delaware corporation authorized to do business in Missouri, and files this verified Application pursuant to Sections 392.361, 392.410, 392.420, 392.430, 392.450, 392.455 R.S.Mo. and 4 CSR 240-2.060(1) and (4) requesting Certificates of Service Authority to provide basic local telecommunications services, local exchange telecommunications services, exchange access services, and interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Missouri and to classify the company and its services as competitive. In support of its application, Applicant states as follows:

- 1. Applicant is a limited liability corporation duly organized and existing under the laws of the State of Delaware, duly authorized to do business in the State of Missouri. A certificate from the Missouri Secretary of State reflecting Applicant's authority to do business in the State of Missouri is attached hereto as Exhibit I. Applicant's principal business and mailing address is 1801 Pennsylvania Avenue, N.W., Washington, D.C. 20006..

Notices, correspondence, communications, orders, decisions, and other papers may be served upon Applicant's attorneys and such service shall be deemed to be service upon Applicant in this matter.

3. Applicant seeks permission and authority to operate as a facilities-based and resale provider of intrastate basic local telecommunications services and exchange access services throughout the exchanges of the local exchange service areas of Southwestern Bell Telephone Company (SWBT), GTE Midwest, Incorporated (GTE), and United Telephone Company of Missouri d/b/a Sprint (Sprint). A list of these exchanges is attached hereto as Exhibit II. Applicant's proposed basic local service areas will follow such exchange boundaries and will be no smaller than an exchange. Applicant also seeks permission and authority to operate as a facilities-based and resale provider of intrastate local non-switched private line telecommunications services (dedicated, high capacity point-to-point transmission facilities) and switched and dedicated interexchange telecommunications services throughout the State of Missouri. Applicant will offer basic local telecommunications services as a separate and distinct service and will provide equitable access for

Missouri customers without regard to income or place of residence to affordable telecommunications services in its service area.

- 4. Applicant McImetro LLC together with McI Telecommunications Corporation, McImetro, Inc., and McImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., have filed with the Commission, concurrent with the instant Application, an Application for Approval of Merger, a copy of which is attached hereto as Exhibit III, and incorporated herein by reference.
- 5. The local network which will be used and installed if this Application is granted will be identical to the existing network MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc., to-wit:

A state of the art telecommunications network that will serve as a platform for providing a full range of local services. The quality of the basic local telecommunications services which Applicant will provide in the State of Missouri will be equal to or superior to the quality of the basic local telecommunications services that customers in the State of Missouri are currently receiving from the incumbent providers. Applicant intends to provide telecommunications services both as a facilities-based provider and reseller of other telecommunications providers' services.

6. Applicant has ample technical and managerial resources and abilities. The experience and background of Applicant's officers and employees, including those who will have primary responsibility for providing telecommunications services to customers in the State of Missouri, are identical as that for MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc. which was recognized by the Commission in its Report and Order issued in Case No. TA-96-355 on February 21, 1997.

Applicant's financial resources and abilities to support its operations in Missouri are also identical to MCImetro Access Transmission Services, Inc.

- 7. Applicant also seeks classification of itself and its telecommunications services as competitive and accompanying reduced regulation, pursuant to Sections 392.361 and 392.420 R.S.Mo. The existing monopoly services of SWBT, GTE and Sprint will make the basic local markets Applicant seeks to enter sufficiently competitive to make a lesser degree of regulation for Applicant's proposed services in the public interest and consistent with the legislative policies established in Section 392.185 R.S.Mo. Additionally, the services of a wide variety of providers of interexchange services and non-switched local services have previously been classified as competitive by the Commission.
- 8. Applicant will hold certificates identical to those issued to MCImetro by this Commission in Case No. TA-96-355 and will continue MCImetro's operations under the same management upon approval of this Application and the merger Application. Applicant intends to adopt the tariffs now filed with this Commission by MCImetro.
- 9. Applicant will comply with all applicable statutes and Commission rules, regulations, decisions, and orders governing the provision of Applicant's services. Applicant's basic local services will satisfy the minimum standards established by the Commission. Application will file and maintain basic local service tariff(s) with the Commission in the same manner and form as the Commission requires of incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies with which Applicant seeks to compete. Applicant will meet the minimum basic local service standards, including quality of service and billing standards, as the Commission requires of the incumbent local exchange telecommunications companies with which Applicant seeks to compete. Applicant requests that the following statutes and regulations be waived regarding all of its services, consistent with the Commission's decisions regarding other companies:

- 10. Applicant submits the public interest will be served by approval of this Application because Applicant's services will create competition in certain basic local telecommunications and exchange access markets, and increase competition in other telecommunication markets, increasing the variety and number of telecommunications options available to customers and expanding the range of customer choices, consistent with the Commission's policies, the legislative goals set forth in Section 392.185 R.S.Mo., and the Telecommunications Act of 1996.
- 10. By this application, Applicant demonstrates that it has the technical, managerial and financial resources and abilities to provide telecommunications services for the benefit of the public. Further, Applicant demonstrates that all such services and Applicant itself should be classified as competitive subject to reduced regulation.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests the Commission to grant it Certificates of Service Authority to provide basic local telecommunications services, local exchange telecommunications services, exchange access services, and interexchange telecommunications services, in the areas of the State of Missouri described above, classify Applicant and its services as competitive, waive the aforesaid statutes and regulations, and grant such other and further relief as to the Commission seems meet and proper in the premises.


